On this Third Sunday of Easter Jesus instructs Peter to “Feed my lambs,” and “Tend my sheep.” These are instructions for us as well, making it clear to us that we have a responsibility to more than ourselves; we also are called to care for and most especially love those around us. The Easter Season is actually from Easter Sunday to Pentecost — 50 days! And is celebrated in joyful exultation as one feast day, or better, as one “great Sunday”. These above all others are the days for the singing of the Alleluia. The paschal candle, a symbol of the presence of the risen Christ among the people of God, remains in the sanctuary near the altar or ambo through Pentecost Sunday. Our readings on this Third Sunday of Easter augment the continuance of the Easter season and our Easter celebrations. The First Reading from the Acts of the Apostles continues the narrative of what happened after Jesus’ death and resurrection, what the Apostles did and where and how they did it. This reading speaks specifically of how the Apostles were brought before the Sanhedrin, the Jewish council, because they (the Apostles) had not conformed to the orders they had received.
