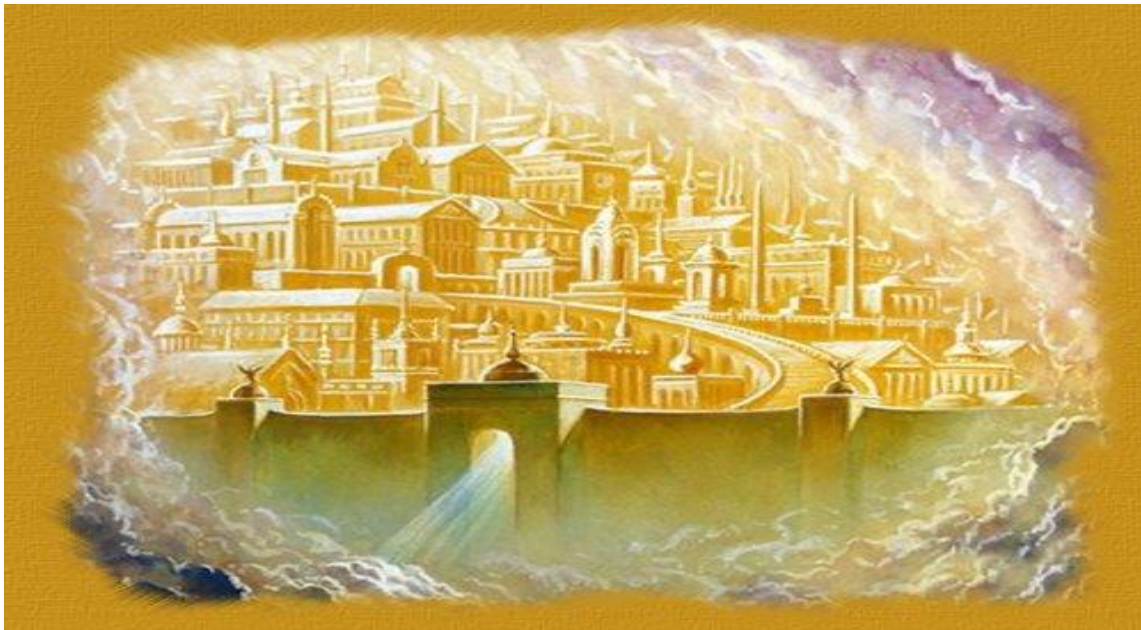

God proclaims at the end of our Second Reading from the Book of Revelations, "Behold, I make all things new." That is a good thing to remember on this Fifth Sunday of Easter. In the opening verse of this reading from Holy Scripture, John also says, "I...saw a new heaven and a new earth." Easter reveals this newness to us, and we must always keep it in mind. The Greek word used for what is translated as "new" is *kaine*. As is normally the case, that particular Greek word has multiple meanings, one of which is "fresh." We are not speaking of a heaven and earth which did not exist before, but of a heaven and earth which are fresh in their newness. This is not just a "new" perspective, but a better one. If we strive to live out our lives as disciples of Christ, if we make a complete effort to be His disciples, we inherit this new heaven.
