Charles Spaulding
1874-1952**

Charles Spaulding spent much time giving motivational speeches at colleges, although he himself only had an 8th grade education. A quiet, earnest man, he built a struggling business into the largest Black insurance company in the world. His job with the infant North Carolina Mutual Life Insurance Company meant everything from bookkeeper and field agent to janitor. In 1926, he received the Harmon Gold award for Distinguished Achievement. The African American community can be proud of their business pioneers— past and present.
