The Missionaries of Our Lady of La Salette

Fr. Thomas Vellappillil was born in India, and spent the first four years after ordination working in the Philippines. He has been ministering in the USA for over 20 years; first he was in the ministry of education and formation of seminarians and then in pastoral ministry. He is now Director of the La Salette Mission center since January 2011, where his goal is to raise funds for La Salette Missionaries working in poor and underdeveloped mission countries. It will be his pleasure to speak to you about the mission activity of the Church and the La Salette Missionaries. Having brought the fulness of life to our world when He rose from the dead, Jesus sent his disciples to share this life with all of creation. "They went forth and preached everywhere" (Mk 16:20). The Missionaries of Our Lady of La Salette minister to people of every race, language, culture and way of life—beginning at the La Salette Shrine in France where our Blessed Mother appeared in 1846. Her final words, "Well, my children, you will make this known to all my people," echo Jesus' Gospel mandate. It is little wonder that the La Salette Congregation has always been mission oriented. When called upon by the Vatican to preach the Gospel in foreign lands, they eagerly respond. This spirit brought them to mission in 27 countries, especially among the poor in Angola, Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Haiti, India, Madagascar, Myanmar, Tanzania, the Philippines and most recent, Mozambique. With your cooperation, the Missionaries of La Salette can continue to provide spiritual and financial assistance to these mission countries as they bring God's reconciling message to the poor.

Dear Fr. Noel: As we discussed earlier, I understand that an outstanding balance of \$43,251.67 remains for unpaid payroll taxes and other costs related to Our Mother of Mercy School. This debt was incurred as a result of assistance provided to Our Mother of Mercy School prior to its closing. As a parochial school, the debts of the school are considered the responsibility of the parish and repayment of the debt should be assumed by the parish. Our Mother of Mercy has been diligent in significantly reducing the parish loan with the intent of paying off the loan. These efforts indicate acknowledgement of the parish's financial responsibilities. In light of these positive efforts, and, in the interest of the mission of the Church, I approve your request to write-off the debt related to Our Mother of Mercy School. Please coordinate this adjustment with Sabrina Vrooman, Chief Financial Officer. Please also inform your parishioners of the generosity of the Diocese resulting from forgiveness of this debt. Thank you for working with me for the good of the community of Our Mother of Mercy Church.
